Prefix	Meaning	Examples
Re-	To do again	Repay, redo, remake, recall
Un-	Not	Unfair, unlike, unbelievable
Pre-	To do before	Prepay, prejudice

SUFFIXES

Suffix	Meaning	Examples
-less	Without	Hopeless, careless, homeless
-ness	Quality or state of	Happiness, playfulness
-ful	Full of	Hopeful, cheerful, gleeful
